

**RESOLUTION REQUIRING THE REMOVAL OF POLITICAL
SIGNS AND POSTERS AFTER ELECTIONS**

WHEREAS, there are numerous regulations and policies aimed at keeping North Carolina and its communities safe and beautiful; and


WHEREAS, most counties and cities have ordinances or rules and regulations governing the placement and removal of signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Warren County Board of Commissioners the following:

1. Every political sign, poster, bill or placard placed in Warren County (and not located on private property with the permission of the property owner) shall be removed within five (5) days following the final determination of the results of the election to which the same is applicable.
2. Said removal shall be the personal responsibility of the candidate (in whose support the political sign, poster, bill or placard is solicited) if said candidate resides in Warren County, North Carolina; if said candidate does not reside in Warren County, North Carolina, then said responsibility shall be that of the Campaign Manager in Warren County of said respective candidate.


